2. Project Updates (TASA/TAP and STBG)

Buchanan County

David said the Quasqueton Diagonal Blvd project is undergoing comments for a January letting. The right of way and roadway clearance have been purchased. Bids came in much higher than anticipated for the county's bridge restoration project at Taylor's Ford Bridge. The project has TASA funds through the RTA. The county is revisiting options on how best to proceed.

Bremer County

Moore said the deck for the C50 bridge was poured yesterday. The county is closing their third remaining HPB bridge.

There was no general discussion.

There being no further business, it was moved by Ohrt, seconded by Wikner to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 2:07 PM.

I am writing on behalf of the Iowa Northland Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) to express our enthusiastic support for the Pioneer Trail project spearheaded by the Grundy County Conservation Board. This vital initiative seeks to complete the 1.3-mile gap between the City of Reinbeck and the adjacent 6-mile section of the trail.

The RTA has reviewed the project for consistency with its 2050 Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and Bikeway Plan subcomponent. Based on this review, we confirm that the proposed project aligns with and supports the goals and objectives of the LRTP and Bikeway Plan. The project has strong local and regional support, and your assistance will help advance this identified regional priority.

The construction of this segment of the Pioneer Trail is critical for enhancing safety and accessibility for trail users who currently face significant risks with truck and auto traffic on lowa 175. This project will provide a safer route, encouraging outdoor activities without highway hazards. Full completion of the Pioneer Trail will link four rural communities, three city parks, and six county wildlife areas in Grundy County, enriching recreational opportunities and boosting local businesses and tourism. This application will bring the County within reach of completing the Pioneer Trail, leaving just one gap remaining.

For over four decades, the Grundy County Conservation Board has worked tirelessly to realize the vision of a fully connected Pioneer Trail. Their commitment, combined with the support of local communities and stakeholders, has been pivotal in reaching this stage of development.

The Pioneer Trail is a great project for promoting economic development, public health, and outdoor activity in Grundy County. We urge your strong consideration to award funding to the Grundy County Conservation Board.
