3 Funding Opportunities Available

Every year, the Black Hawk County MPO administers three federal programs passed through the Iowa DOT: CRP, STBG, and TA Set-Aside. This year, **\$6.1 million dollars** is available in total to program towards transportation-related projects in the Black Hawk County MPO. Read more below!

Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TA Set-Aside)

This program provides funding to expand travel choices and improve the transportation experience. TA Set-Aside projects improve the cultural, historic, aesthetic, and environmental aspects of transportation infrastructure. Eligible projects include bicycle and pedestrian facilities, restoration of historic transportation facilities, and more.
